- Michael trying to address the referee shortage
- We need more involvement from senior members to ensure basic rules are “policed”
- Rosters to be drawn up in future to ensure coverage by at least other committee members

General Business

1) Summer competition

- Q-Genes Mixed were withdrawn due to forfeits and unfinancial status, replaced with “Thrust Party” after 3 rounds at a discounted entry fee
- In future the administrator will have the authority to decline team nominations without consulting other committee members

2) Representatives

- New playing gear Ali and Nat still undecided – designs not agreed upon. Kombat clothing is the preferred option - pricing to be finalised by 1st December 2006
- Shorts to be purchased in bulk – WB sports with players to purchase and keep. Females to be given an option of “shorts” style, males to have “football” style.
- Shirts to be returned after each tournament, with spare sets to be obtained. Selection Policy for future teams needs to be drawn up
- Teams withdrawing from tournaments after acceptance fees have been paid are becoming a continual problem.
- Coaches to be appointed on an annual basis in future, which will require early identification
- NRE sponsorship to be revisited by Ali Day – report back by 1st December

3) Suns Regionals
